Summary

In this unit, students will continue to learn how to use computers **safely, effectively and responsibly**.

Students will be reminded of how to stay safe from **phishing, sexting, and grooming** and other vital E-Safety issue that young adults can be affected and influenced by.



Key Vocabulary

Attachment	A file that is sent with an e-mail.
Anti-virus	Anti-virus software scans all forms of storage devices for viruses and, if found, attempts to remove them.
Cyberbullying	Cyberbullying involves sending offensive texts or emails, posting lies or insults on social networking sites and sharing embarrassing videos or photos online.
Digital Footprint	A digital footprint occurs when searches on websites are stored, images and videos are upload to social media sites or you are tagged into such things by your friends.
Grooming	Refers to the techniques predators use to get to know and seduce their victims in preparation for different forms of abuse.
Phishing	Trying to trick someone into giving out information over email is called 'phishing'.

Digital Footprint

A digital footprint is data that is left behind when users have been online. There are two types of digital footprints which are passive and active. A passive footprint is made when information is collected from the user without the person knowing this is happening. An active digital footprint is where the user has deliberately shared information about themselves either by [using social media sites](#) or by using websites.

Child Sexual Exploitation

Child sexual exploitation (CSE) is a type of **sexual abuse**. When a child or young person is exploited they're given things, like gifts, drugs, money, status and affection, in exchange for performing sexual activities. Children and young people are often tricked into believing they're in a loving and consensual relationship. This is called **grooming**. They may trust their abuser and not understand that they're being abused.
