

Dear parents, carers & students

We hope you are having a good summer but no doubt are both excited and anxious about your GCSE/BTEC results.

There has been considerable coverage in the media about potential issues with the final results. We want to reassure you that we followed a rigorous process to finalise the Centre Assessed Grades before submitting them to the examination boards.

We have been asked to forward the email below from Ofqual – the organisation that oversees the results.

Also, attached is a 'student guide' to the process and information about appeals if this is deemed appropriate.

A reminder that results can be collected on Thursday 20th August.

We ask that students arrive at school on their own to collect their results in the time slot provided as detailed below.

Time slot	First initial of surname
10.00 – 10.30	A to D
10.45 – 11.15	E to I
11.30 – 12.00	J to P
12.15 – 12.45	R to S
1.00 to 1.30	T to Z

As mentioned in a previous letter, we cannot allow friends and family on site to collect the results with students, due to numbers.

Students will be asked to line up using the markings on the ground to ensure social distancing when waiting for results.

If a student is unable to collect their results and wish for someone else to collect the results on their behalf, they should have put this in writing before the end of term.

The person collecting the results must have a form of identification with them on results day. If results are not collected on this day they will be posted to the student.

Students will be given the opportunity to request their centre assessed grades and to request to take exams in November if they wish.

There will be more details about this handed out on results day.
