Definitions

Design Brief: A short statement telling you what to do.

Specification: A list of everything you will need to make your product.

Research:

Investigations and studies to support product development

Prototype:

A first version of a product from which others are deveoped.

Generating Ideas

Follow the Design Process and understand the different roles within this. Combine influences and ideas to make an appealing product. Communicate and develop ideas.

Making Ideas

Add colour to fabric using transfer methods including the heat press. Add decoration and texture using hand and machine methods. Use the sewing machine to construct a product.

Analyse products to support idea development. Reflect on and improve designs to meet the interests and needs of the intended user.

Technical Knowledge

Understand the different parts of the sewing machine & their function. Understand techniques & health and safety aspects of the heat press and transfer method.
